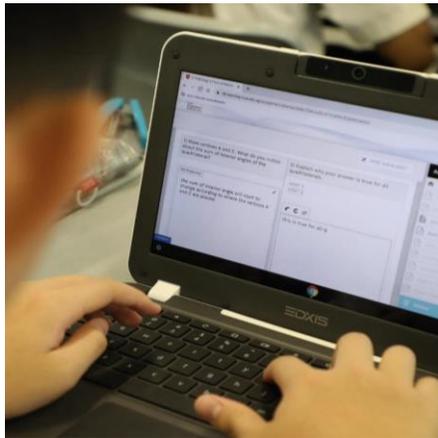

BL Day – Important Points

<p>Pre-BL Day</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Students without a conducive environment for learning may inform HTs of their intent to return to school for BL Day. The School Library will be open and light snacks will be provided. <input type="checkbox"/> BL Day instructions will be uploaded in respective Google Classrooms by Thursday 5 pm.
<p>During BL Day</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Inform HTs and subject teacher if unable to attend scheduled synchronous lesson (8 – 9 am). <input type="checkbox"/> Contact subject teachers (<i>refer to instructions from teachers</i>) in case any questions arises. <input type="checkbox"/> Typical deadline to complete BL Day assignment: By Sunday evening before 10.30 pm
<p>Post-BL Day</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Students who did not complete BL Day assignments will be made to stay back to complete after school. <input type="checkbox"/> Parents will be informed. <input type="checkbox"/> Students who fail to complete BL Day assignments repeatedly will be required to report to school for subsequent BL Days for the rest of the term.

BL Day – Netiquette

- ❑ Be **punctual** for lessons and **prepare learning materials**
- ❑ **Dress appropriately** (*i.e. no singlets nor pyjamas allowed*)
- ❑ Select an **appropriate location** (*e.g. study room / living room / dining room. Do not take a video call in your bedroom or toilet.*)
- ❑ Ensure that your device is connected to a **stable and strong wireless network**
- ❑ **Turn on webcam** during videoconferencing sessions
- ❑ **Mute your microphone when not speaking** (*otherwise there will be annoying feedback from the speakers!*)

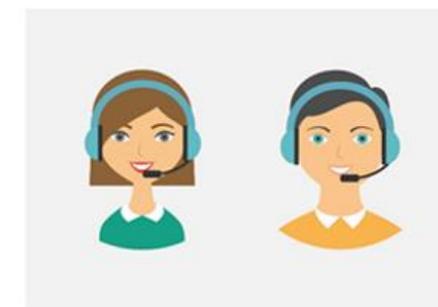
