- ❑ **Higher Mother Tongue Languages (HMTL)**
  - ❑ Higher Chinese Language & Higher Malay Language are ***offered in PRSS***
  - ❑ **Eligibility**
    - ❑ Students who attain *AL1 / AL2 in MTL* **OR** *Distinction / Merit in HMTL*
- ❑ **HMTL lesson venues**
  - ❑ HCL - Pasir Ris Secondary School
  - ❑ HML - Pasir Ris Secondary School
  - ❑ HTL - Pasir Ris Crest Secondary School
- ❑ **Tamil Languages**
  - ❑ Tamil Language & Higher Tamil Language are offered at Tamil Language Centres
  - ❑ **Designated Centre for PRSS: Changkat Changi Secondary School [opposite Simei MRT]**
- ❑ **Non-Tamil Indian Languages (NTIL)**
  - ❑ PRSS is a designated Hindi Weekend Centre

# Information on Mother Tongue Languages

## ❑ Third Languages (L3)

- ❑ The L3s which students are eligible for are indicated in their Eligibility Letter and S1 Option Form
- ❑ If a particular L3 is not indicated, the student is not eligible for that L3.
- ❑ Students are to indicate the choices of L3 via the S1 Internet System or his/her primary school.

2	Arabic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Offered at MOELC Bishan.</li><li>• Students must obtain a PSLE Score of 24 or better.</li><li>• If no. of applicants is more than the no. of vacancies, applicants are selected based on PSLE results.</li><li>• For Bahasa Indonesia, students must not have offered ML/HML as their MTL at PSLE.</li><li>• SC/PR or children of SC/PR.</li></ul>

3	French	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students must obtain a PSLE Score of 8 or better.</li><li>• If no. of applicants is more than the no. of vacancies, applicants are selected based on PSLE results.</li><li>• SC/PR or children of SC/PR.</li><li>• Offered CL/ML/TL/NTIL at PSLE.</li><li>• To offer Japanese, students must have offered CL/HCL at PSLE.</li></ul>
