CCA Achievements

CCAs are conduits for our students to discover their interests and strengths beyond the academics, and to develop students holistically. Our students have done well in their respective CCAs in Semester 1 2024 where they developed key traits such as leadership, student agency and resilience through engaging learning experiences in CCAs.

Our various Performing Arts groups, the Chinese Orchestra, Choir, Concert Band, Modern Dance and English Drama put up a spectacular musical showcase 'The Pursuit' on 3 May 2024 and were treated to an Appreciation Tea by the school for their efforts and achievements. Our B Division Basketball Boys Team emerged Top 8 in the NSG East Zone Basketball Championships while our Football Boys competed at League 1 in the National School Games Football Championships. The uniformed groups (NCC Land, NCDCC and NPCC) were all recognised as Distinction units. Such accomplishments would be impossible without the passion and grit of teachers and students. 🔜 Overseas Learning Trip to Brunei

The overseas trip to Brunei took place from 5 to 8 May 2024 with 4 teachers and 30 Sec 3 students to broaden knowledge educational, their of emerging technological and economic trends in the region. They had a meaningful experience learning from staff and students from Sekolah Menengah Berakas and visiting the Eco Ponies Garden where they learned about sustainable farming practices. They also visited the Eco Corridor and Bukit Sepatir to learn about the importance of conserving nature. Through this trip, students immersed themselves in the rich culture and breathtaking nature in Brunei and were inspired to lead a more sustainable lifestyle.



Overseas Learning Trip to Penang

Some of our Sec 2 and 3 students went on an overseas cultural and school immersion trip to Penang with 4 teachers from 19 to 22 May 2024. The highlights of the trip include interaction and exchange of ideas and experiences on eco-school practices with staff and students from Penang's SMK Convent Butterworth and an industry visit to Paramit Malaysia which is a global contract development and manufacturing firm, known as Factory in a Forest for their sustainable efforts in architectural design and factory operations. Our teachers and students also visited the iconic Penang Hill, Peranakan Museum, Chew Jetty and Armenian Street which featured various forms of street art and Chinese clan houses. Through this trip, students fostered their knowledge of sustainability and strengthened their appreciation and sense of belonging to Singapore.



The 28th Student Council Investiture

The school witnessed the leadership transition of the Student Council during the 28th Student Council Investiture on 21 May 2024. The ceremony not only marks a new chapter for the incoming Student Councillors but also celebrates the achievements and contributions of the outgoing 27th Student Council. CCA Leadership Handover Ceremony

The CCA Leadership Handover Ceremony will take place on 2 July 2024 to mark a significant transition as the new student leaders prepare to assume their roles. This event will also celebrate the achievements of the outgoing leaders and welcome the incoming leaders with a formal handover of responsibilities and artefacts that represent their CCAs.



Authentic Learning and Holistic Development

The school strongly believes in developing students' joy of learning by providing opportunities for students to relate the knowledge and skills acquired from the classroom in the real-world context. As such, the STEAM Carnival featuring inter-disciplinary workshops from Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics was organised for all students from 13 to 17 May. The English Language and Literature Festival was also held from 1 to 5 April where selected students attended author workshops and talks by professionals on honing their public speaking skills. Other highlights include a Sec 3 inter-class debate and the 'Poetry Under the Stars' event where our Upper Secondary students learned about star gazing and were inspired to write their poems.

The school also organised the Student Learning Festival on 24 April, in conjunction with our 39th anniversary celebration, for students to showcase their studentinitiated projects and learn from one another. In the final week of Term 2, Sec 2 students attended the various Cultural Fusion workshops that culminated into a combined level showcase. Our Sec 1 students participated in the Code for Fun programme and our Sec 3 students bonded with their classmates through the annual inter-class games.



Attendance and Temperature-Taking

Exercise

The attendance and temperature-taking exercise for Term 3 will be conducted on **Wednesday, 3 July 2024** for all staff and students. All students are required to bring a functional thermometer for the exercise. The exercise allows schools to maintain their preparedness to re-activate the attendance and temperature-taking regime should the need arise. It will also help to educate students on taking personal responsibility for their own health and social responsibility.

Emergency Exercise

The school will conduct the 2nd Emergency Exercise in August. This emergency exercise aims to train staff and students to be prepared for security incidents that may arise in the school and to be familiar with the safety and evacuation procedures. During this exercise, we will have a lockdown cum an evacuation to an assembly area within the school.



Blended Learning (BL)

Blended Learning will continue in Term 3 and students will participate in at least 1 hour of Student-Initiated Learning (SIL) activity to explore an area of interest beyond the curriculum. For Sec 4 and 5 students, SIL is optional and they may use the time to prepare for the National Examinations instead. The updated BL days for Term 3 are reflected below.
