

Full Subject-Based Banding (fSBB)

- Eligible students from PG 1 and 2 can offer English Language, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics and Science at a more demanding level based on their PSLE Achievement Level (AL) for each of these subjects. These students will receive an offer letter via Parent Gateway by 20 Dec 2024.
- Students are to submit the hard copy forms to the school(General Office) by 24 Dec 2024

• Eligibility

- Option to take subject at G3 level AL5 or better in a Standard level subject
- Option to take subject at G2 level AL6 or better in a Standard level subject OR AL A in a Foundation level subject

Information on Mother Tongue Languages

- Higher Mother Tongue Languages (HMTL)
 - ☐ Higher Chinese Language & Higher Malay Language are *offered in PRSS*
 - Eligibility
 - □ Students who attain an *overall PSLE score of 8 or better* OR
 - □ Students who attain an *overall PSLE score of 9 − 14* AND attained *AL1 / AL2 in MTL* OR *Distinction / Merit in HMTL*
 - □ School will take into consideration students who do not meet the criteria for overall PSLE score but have attained the requisite grades for MTL / HMTL
- Tamil Languages
 - Tamil Language & Higher Tamil Language are offered at Tamil Language Centres [Designated Centre for
