

## Attire and Grooming Guidelines 2012

- 1 Students are to wear the full school uniform when they are in school and when they represent the school at official functions. **Any modification to the uniform is not allowed.** The full school uniform consists of:
  - the school shirt, with the school logo sewn on the left chest pocket
  - the school shorts/ pants/ skirt
  - a pair of shoes which are either fully or predominantly white (thin coloured trimmings are allowed, but not fanciful designs and coloured shoe laces)
  - fully white socks which are visible to an observer
- 2 The school uniform must be clean, well-pressed and tidy. Shirts and blouses must be fitting and neatly tucked in. Shirt sleeves or trousers hemlines must not be folded.
  - The girls' skirts must be A-line and at least of knee length.
  - The boys' long pants should not be pleated, baggy or tapered.
- 3 When permitted by teachers-in-charge of CCA or other activities, students taking part in activities after curriculum hours and during holidays are allowed to wear the following attire:
  - school/ CCA/ class t-shirt worn with the school pants/ shorts/ skirt
  - sports shoes or other covered shoes which serve the purpose of the activityAny other attire, such as home clothes and slippers, is not allowed in school.
- 4 The school tie must be worn on the day of the level assembly held fortnightly. When wearing the tie, the collar button must be fastened and the tie knot should rest firmly at the collar button. The length of the tie should be around the waistline of the student.
- 5 Outlandish, spiky/punkish or dyed/ coloured/ highlighted hair is not allowed. Pupils with dyed hair will be sent home immediately to re-dye the hair.
- 6 Haircut for boys must be short and neat, it should not touch the eye brows, the ears and the collar. The sideburn should not be lower than the half ear mark. Facial hair is not allowed.
- 7 Girls with shoulder-length or longer hair must have it neatly tied or plaited. Fringes should be neatly pinned up such that the forehead and eye brows are not covered. Only black hair accessories can be used.
- 8 For girls, no cosmetics or jewellery is allowed, except for one (black or silver) round ear-stud (5 mm or smaller in diameter) or one pair of transparent ear stick on each ear lobe. Boys are not allowed to wear any accessories at all.
- 9 Students must maintain a high standard of personal hygiene; for example, fingernails are to be kept short and neat.
- 10 Fanciful accessories such as coloured contact lenses, sharp combs and oversized wallets protruding from pockets are not allowed. Body art of any form such as tattooing is strictly not allowed.

## Proper School Attire (Girls)



Only 1 pair of black or silver round plain matching studs (5 mm or less in diameter) or 1 pair of transparent ear sticks is allowed.

Shirt is to be tucked in neatly.

Skirt should be of knee length.



Girls must tidy hair with black accessories eg. clips and pins such that it does not cover eyebrows or the forehead

Girls with shoulder-length or longer hair must tie up their hair neatly.

Fingernails are to be kept short and clean.

Shoes and socks should be white and clean. Socks should be visible to an observer.



## Proper School Attire (Boys)



Hair should not touch the ears and the collar.



Hair to be neatly combed; sideburns should not be lower than the half-ear mark.

Shirt is to be tucked in neatly.



Trousers should not be tapered.

Fingernails are to be kept short and clean.

Shoes and socks should be white and clean. Socks should be visible to an observer.
